FROM THE CHIEF ELECTORAL OFFICER FOR NIUE
2026 Niue General Elections
Notice 4 – 10 April 2026

1. Objections to voter registrations

Who can object

- The electoral Registrar in charge of that electoral Roll.
- A voter whose name appears on that electoral Roll.

What can a Registrar or Voter object to

- The person's name objected to because the person is not qualified to be registered.
- The person's name objected to because the person is not qualified or is no longer qualified to be registered on the relevant electoral Roll.

2. Procedure for an objection by a Voter

- A voter submits an objection Form to the electoral Registrar.
- The Registrar notifies the person objected to.
- The person objected to has 5 days to comment.
- After 5 days the Registrar submits the objection, any reply and any comments or recommendations to the Niue Public Service Commission.
- The Commission investigates and makes a final decision and directs the electoral Registrar or the Chief Electoral Officer to take all the necessary actions.

3. Procedure for an objection by an electoral Registrar

- The electoral Registrar notifies the person objected.
- The person objected to has 4 days to return a notice of appeal to the Registrar and failure to do so will result in that person's name being removed from the Roll.
- If a notice of appeal is received by the electoral Registrar and if the Registrar is satisfied that the person objected is entitled to retain his or her name on the Roll then the Registrar will withdraw his or her objection and notify the person.
- If the Registrar is not satisfied the Registrar will submit his or her objection, the appeal together with any comments to the Niue Public Service Commission for a final decision.

All objections and appeals need to be determined by Tuesday 21 April.

All Forms and Notices of Appeal are available at the Department of Justice, Lands, Survey and Community Services at Fonuakula, Alofi during official hours Monday to Thursday 8am to 4pm.
