2026 Niue General Elections
Notice 8 – 29 April 2026

1. CANDIDATE CAMPAIGNING

All candidate campaigning must end at 6pm on Friday 1 May 2026.

Campaign signs or posters posted up or put up may remain on election day but must not be physically visible from any of the 14 Polling Stations.

2. VOTING IN ADVANCE

Voting in Advance for these General Elections will take place on Friday 1 May 2026 from 9.00am to 1.00pm at the Department of Justice, Lands, Survey and Community Services at the Department of Justice, Lands, Survey and Community Services at Fonuakula, Alofi.

Voting in advance is restricted to:

- registered voters who intend to depart Niue on the Air New Zealand flight on Friday 1 May 2026.
- Members of the Seventh Day Adventist (SDA) Church in Niue who intend to vote at these elections.

All registered voters wanting to vote in advance must:

- Present a valid e-ticket or boarding pass to the Chief Electoral Officer
- Prove they are a member of the SDA Church / Congregation
- Obtain, complete and submit a Declaration Form to vote in advance, on or before Friday 1 May 2026, to the Chief Electoral Officer
- Have the Declaration Form accepted by the Chief Electoral Officer
- Vote between 9am and 1pm on Friday 1 May 2026

Declaration Forms are available from the Department.
