

FIRST FLIGHT WITH PASSENGERS TO NIUE

UPDATE

On Monday 18th October 2021, the first flight from Auckland carrying passengers brought 23 people to the island.

All passengers were taken straight to managed isolation and quarantine for 14 days at the Scenic Matavai Apartments located at Homofiti, Tamakautoga.

All passengers were tested for Covid-19 on arrival (Day 0) and all passengers returned negative Covid-19 results.
