All arrivals into MIQ facilities in Niue return negative tests

Alofi, Niue – 5 November 2021 – The Government of Niue (GON) announced today that all fully vaccinated arrivals currently in the three MIQ facilities have tested negative on their day three test as part of standard testing protocols.

There are currently three active MIQ locations on the island; Homofiti, Matavai and Fuselie.

All 35 passengers who arrived on the Monday, 1 November flight will be released on Sunday, 14 November only if their Day 12 test is negative following COVID protocols.

There is currently one MIQ case that has been transferred to Niue Fook Hospital ACU for close observation. The individual was transferred due to underlying medical conditions and tested negative for Covid.

All medical staff who are attending the case are following strict Infection Prevention and Control procedures to ensure the safety of the individual and the medical staff. The individual's condition is stable.
